VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

Box Office: The event box office will be located near the main concert entry off Murphy's Ave. Tickets will be available on the day, unless sold out in advance. Pre-purchased tickets will be available for collection; however, in order to avoid queues on the day we encourage you to pick up your tickets by Friday 14 March from WIN Entertainment Centre in Wollongong.

Cloakroom Facilities: No cloakroom will be available on-site at the concert. If in doubt, leave it at home or in the car.

Pass-Outs: Will not be available, so ensure that you take everything that you require into the concert upon arrival.

Toilets: Will be located at various points around the concert site.

Food & Beverages: A range of catering outlets will be available along with a licensed bar. Photo ID is required if you wish to purchase and consume alcohol, and service will not be provided to people under 18 years of age. Food is allowed into the concert site, but no alcohol, glass or metal cutlery will be permitted.

First Aid: Will be available on-site.

ATM: No ATM or cash-out facilities will be on-site. Be sure to bring enough cash to see you through the day.

Bags: May be subject to a random safety and security search upon entry. Any prohibited items will be confiscated (see 'What Not To Bring').

Weather: The concert will proceed rain or shine. Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance, so be prepared for either scenario.

GETTING THERE

The concert site is located off Murphy's Ave near Gleniffer Brae Manor House. Take the University of Wollongong exit from the Southern Fwy (F6), then left into Irvine St and right into Murphy's Ave. If you're planning to park on University of Wollongong grounds then turn right onto Irvine St and follows this straight through to the Eastern University entrance on the corner of Northfields Ave.

Buses: Regular weekend bus services will run to the University of Wollongong until 6.00pm on Sunday. (visit www.premierillawarra.com.au for details).

A replacement bus service to Wollongong will run from 6.30-10.30pm. This route will take in Wollongong Rail, Nth Wollongong Rail and the Kenny/Keira St car park.

Parking: University of Wollongong parking facilities are available for the use of concert patrons. The following car-parks will be open and accessible via the Western and Eastern University entries off Northfields Avenue: South Western Car Park; Western Car Park; Main Car Park; Northern Car Park; Ovals Car Park; and UniCentre Car Park. Please refer to signage in each car park for applicable fees. Limited on-street parking is also available surrounding the Wollongong Botanic Garden.

Disabled Access: Limited disabled parking is available through the main gates to Gleniffer Brae Manor House, off Murphy's Ave.

WHAT TO BRING

- Sealed plastic bottles of water or soft drink
- Small quantities of food (no eskies)
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Low beach style chairs, picnic blankets, rugs, cushions and/or pillows
- Pocket-sized personal cameras and camera phones allowed
- Cash (remember, no ATM or cash-out facilities available on-site)

WHAT NOT TO BRING*

- including, but not limited to
- Glass (containers, bottles, glasses)
 - Strictly no BYO alcohol. This is a licensed event.
 - Metal utensils (cutlery)
 - Illegal substances
 - Weapons of any kind
 - Studded wristbands &/or belts etc
 - Fireworks
 - Umbrellas
 - Sun/rain shelters
 - Video and sound recording devices
 - Large professional cameras
 - Animals (guide dogs excluded)
 - Any other items considered illegal or dangerous to yourself or others

*Prohibited items will be confiscated. If in doubt leave it at home or in your car.
